The Center for International Security and Strategy at Tsinghua University(CISS), established on 7 November 2018, is a research institution that analyzes international security and strategy issues, including diplomacy and international relations, global security governance, and artificial intelligence. The Center aims at providing policymakers with recommendations on resolving some of the world's most pressing security issues, as well as enhancing the international community's understanding of China's ideas and policies.

Steered by a Management Committee headed by Mme. Fu Ying, adjunct professor of Tsinghua University, the Center has an Academic Committee that provides academic guidance, and an Advisory Committee and Development Council that serve as advisory bodies. The Center also consists of five sub-centers and one secretariat, namely, the Research Center for International Security Governance, the Research Center for China-US Relationship and Research Center for Multi-disciplinary Research on New Technology and National Security, the Research Center for Asia-Pacific Maritime Security and Governance Studies, the Research Center for Regional Security Risks, the Strategy and Policy Consulting Department and the China Forum Secretariat.

## Chair's Message



It is my honor to be appointed as an Adjunct Professor of Tsinghua University and also to establish the Center for International Security and Strategy (CISS) of Tsinghua University. My sincere gratitude goes to the generous support that Tsinghua faculty and students have given me and my team.

Working at Tsinghua is for me both an honor and a heavy responsibility. Renowned at home and abroad, Tsinghua has left profound marks on China's contemporary history, and it has witnessed the ups and downs of the nation. Today, it continues to make substantial progress as China continues to prosper.

China is now experiencing fast development and changes, which is also true of the world. Our nation has become an important driving force for global changes. Yet, it is also profoundly influenced by them. This special and close interconnectivity has raised the bar for China's research on international issues. Tsinghua University, as one of the most prestigious universities in China and even worldwide, features plentiful interdisciplinary research resources and boasts abundant experience in research on international issues. To better explore the current strategic and security issues challenging China, and to find inspiration for tackling problems and difficulties with the support and resources of the University, we have proposed building the CISS, a new policy research think tank at Tsinghua University.

The report of the 18th National Congress of the Communist Party of China (CPC) emphasized the role of think tanks, and the report of the 19th CPC National Congress clearly proposed the construction of new think tanks with Chinese characteristics. China's think tanks are crucial to achieving the goals of making policy decisions scientifically and democratically, in accordance with the law. CISS has been exploring the establishment of think tanks in an effort to meet China's current strategic and development needs while making contributions to the nation's development. Think tanks are not "ivory towers." Doing research on international issues requires paying close attention to both reality and actual needs. Think tanks should adhere to the political direction of serving the Party, the country and the people, and they should sharpen their research and judgment abilities, as well as their ability to propose policy suggestions. While the outside world has expected more voices from China

in recent years, biased and misleading information about China are still found everywhere. Therefore, China's think tanks should do more and speak more, and the CISS will also spare no effort in paying attention to this cause.

The CISS works to fulfill two main missions: one is to track and study issues such as the world order, the global landscape, security situations and international relations to make judgments and suggestions for policy-making; the second is to introduce, explain and disseminate our development ideas and basic propositions on relevant domestic and foreign policies through various forms of international exchange and cooperation.

The CISS is currently dedicated to two large research projects, namely "Global Security Governance" and "Artificial Intelligence and Security." Based on our own research strengths, we have built a special expert committee and a joint research team under the principle of multi-level collaboration. This will attract well-known scholars from both Tsinghua and other institutions to inspire insightful opinions, supervise studies and research, and absorb researchers from inside and outside the university into the joint research team to carry out specific research projects. We have also launched the "China Forum of the CISS" to help enhance the ability of domestic scholars and the press to communicate with the international community and advance public diplomacy.

Tsinghua University follows the motto of "Self-Discipline and Social Commitment" and the school spirit of "Actions Speak Louder Than Words." Its lofty reputation has attracted numerous students from afar. As a new member of Tsinghua, I believe that with the strategic arrangements made by university leaders to keep pace with international academic frontiers, meet the major national strategic demands and strive to deliver high-level research achievements — along with the generous support from our rigorous and enlightened faculty — the work of the CISS is certain to be carried out steadily. I'm looking forward to making progress with you on the Tsinghua Campus. ”

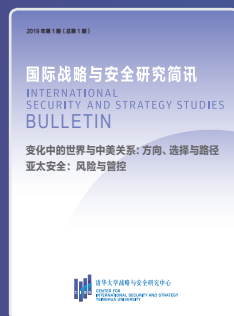

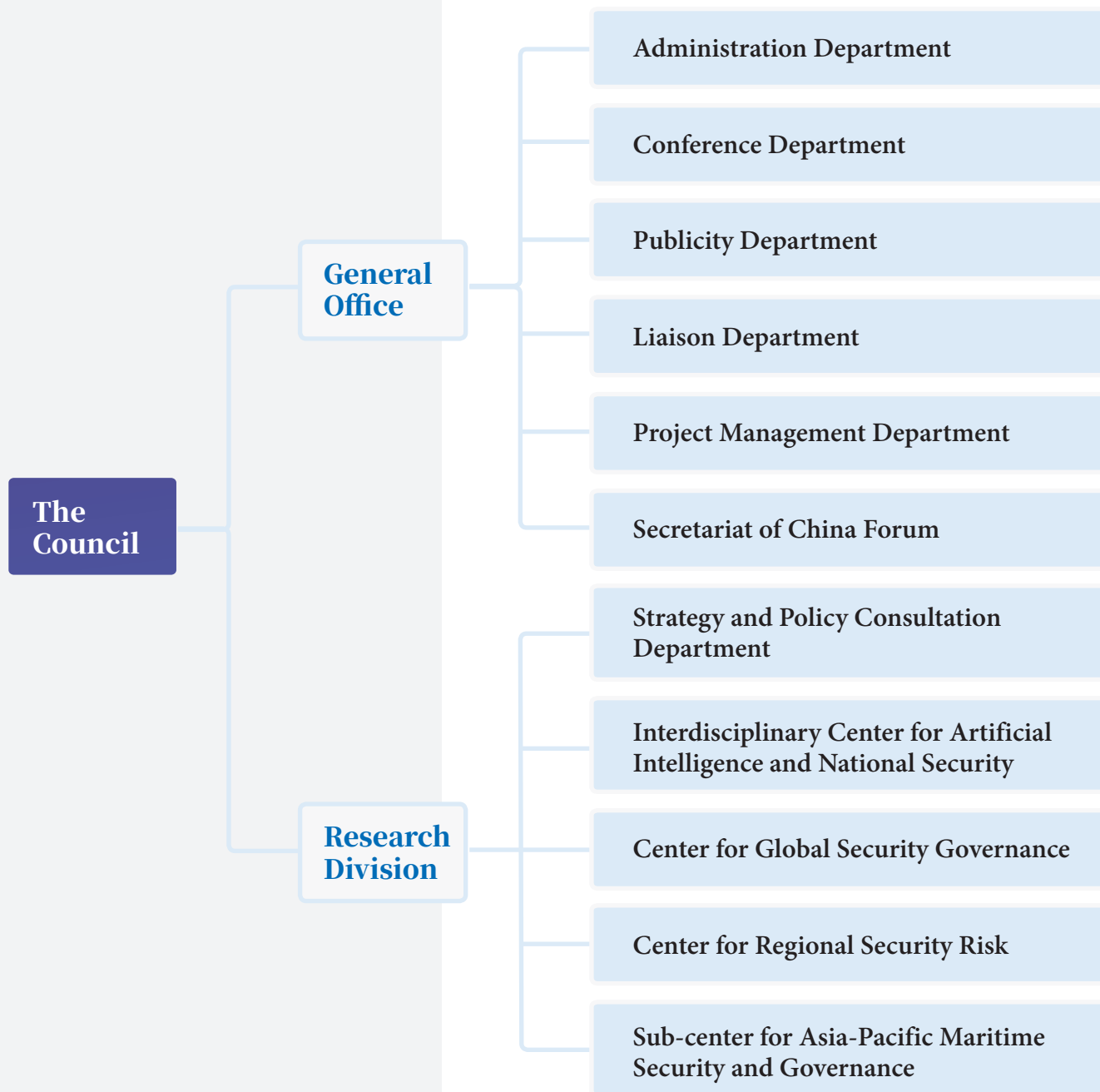
